Smoking - A policy towards a smoke-free environment

Principles Wildern aims to be a school committed to a smoke-free environment.

The school:

- Plays a central role in promoting a healthy life style.
- Recognises smoking is a health and safety issue for all adults and children who use the school.
- Recognises passive smoking is potentially fatal, smoking is the single most preventable cause of premature death and ill health in our society.
- Gives a clear message that at Wildern 'smoke-free' is the norm.

- Practice**
1. Smoking is not allowed on the school site at any time.
 2. All literature, including advertisements, will clearly state that the school has a smoking policy.
 3. During interviews, registration for courses, etc., it will be clearly stated that the school has a smoking policy.
 4. The use of e-cigarettes is not permitted on the school site.

The Headteacher, the Governing Body and those responsible for the provision of out of school facilities are responsible for upholding the Policy.
